### **'Be Ready Warrandyte!'**

'Be Ready Warrandyte – Living with Bushfire Risk' is the banner for the Warrandyte Community Association's 'Fire Ready Community Project' soon to be launched in Warrandyte and the surrounding area.

WCA President, Dick Davies, said "The first task is to survey to the current level of bushfire knowledge and preparedness in the 'Greater Warrandyte' area.

"We may think we have a plan and know what we will do if there is a fire, but what happens if things go wrong? What's plan B or C if we can't get out or defend our property?"

"The survey document is now ready and road tested and will be available both online and in print to residents from mid-August. It will also be available as a supplement to the September issue of the Diary.

"We are asking Warrandyte, North Warrandyte, South Warrandyte and Park Orchards residents to take 15 minutes to complete the survey and contribute to our understanding of our community's fire readiness."
